

LAKE ELLEN BOATING REGULATIONS 101.May 23

To: All Lake Ellen Residents, Renters, Campsites, Trailer Parks, and Guests/Visitors

From: THE LAKE ELLEN ASSOCIATION

1. MOTOR BOATING is to be Counter-Clockwise and in the middle of the lake within the confines of the buoys. (Please avoid hitting the buoys!)

2. MOTOR BOATING HOURS

Monday through Saturday: 10:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. Sunday: 10:00 a.m. to 12:00 Noon

3:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m.

ALL OTHER TIMES: SLOW-NO-WAKE (i.e., the lowest possible speed at

which the craft shall maintain steerage)

3. *JET-SKIS* (and related-type craft)

Jet-Skis are limited to SLOW-NO-WAKE at all times on the entire lake.

- 4. All motor boats pulling water skis or towing any other device on which a person or persons are riding shall have at least two (2) persons in the motor boat.
- 5. There is to be NO wake at all times during a %high-water+situation. this is to prevent shore erosion. (%high-water+is determined per the Town of Lyndon by the Sanitary Commission, and a notice with a flag is posted at the public boat landing.)
- 6. No person shall operate a motor boat closer than two hundred feet (200) to any other boats, canoes, or swimmers unless traveling at slow, no-wake speeds.
- 7. Landing Area Regulations:
 - a. No parking in launch area, except as specified.
 - b. Hours: 6:00 a.m. to 11:00 p.m., except for launching/retrieval of boats.
 - c. No dogs may run at large; must be leashed.
 - d. Clean Boats/Clean Waters inspector will monitor boats starting the first full weekend of May through Labor Day.
- 8. Enhanced wakes are strictly banned on Lake Ellen at all times.
- 9. Underwater swimmers: Please avoid boating in areas where floating red flags mark the presence of underwater swimmers.
- 10. All Town of Lyndon Chapter 8 Boating Regulations, June 2022, are in effect. They can be found at the public landing, LakeEllen.com, and TownofLyndon.com.

All of these provisions are for the safety of all Lake Ellen users; please boat carefully and be mindful of other boats and swimmers.
